Sparkling Wine

Italy

101 Prosecco Borgo Alato, NV Glass £6.75 £36.00
Light silver colour, sparkling, lovely fresh aromas and bouncy, medium dry flavours with a light texture.

102 Prosecco Rosato Borgo Alato, NV Glass £6.75 £36.00
It is fragrant with summer fruit aromas, fresh and lively on the palate, dry, crisp and all too easy to drink.

Champagne

Taittinger

114 Taittinger **V** Glass £12.75 £66.00
The brilliant body is golden yellow in colour. The bubbles are fine, while the foam is discreet yet lingering. The nose, very open and expressive, delivers aromas of fruit and brioche. It also gives off the fragrance of peach, white flowers (hawthorn, acacia) and vanilla pod. The entry onto the palate is lively, fresh and in total harmony. This is a delicate wine with flavours of fresh fruit and honey.

Bollinger

109 Ayala ½ Bottle £35.00 Glass £9.50 £50.00
The sister to Bollinger, this champagne is pale gold in colour with a fine mousse. This wine is rich and aromatic on the nose. On the palate, it is well balanced and shows great finesse and complexity.

107 Ayala Rosé Brut Majeur £65.00
This Rosé Champagne has beautiful delicate cherry colour with a copper hue. A fine and delicate mousse with aromas of berries, cherries and spice. It is well balanced with a rich, fresh, long lasting finish.

Veuve Clicquot

111 Veuve Clicquot Ponsardin, Yellow Label **V** £76.00
Established in 1772, the Veuve Clicquot benefits from a long history but has also benefited from being operated by Madame Clicquot, who at the age of 27 came into control of the House after her husband passed away. With its complex biscuity flavours and fine mousse the Yellow Label of Veuve Clicquot is a given at times of celebration.

Laurent Perrier

106 Laurent Perrier Brut **V** £70.00
A lighter house style. Subtle citrus, toast and spice predominate this perfectly balanced Champagne, with a strong structure giving the wine good food compatibility.



Half Bottles

White

508 Domaine Le Fief de la Brie – Muscadet Sevre & Maine, France 2018 ✓ £18.00

An attractive white with crisp acidity that is ideal with seafood.

504 Chablis, Les Valéry, Jean Durup 2018 ✓ £31.00

This is textbook Chablis from one of the area's most successful producers. It has green-tinged hues, an elegant slightly steely quality with aromas and flavours of freshly baked brioche.

507 Pask 'Gimblett Gravels' Sauvignon Blanc, Hawke's Bay 2018 £18.00

A typical New Zealand Sauvignon with opulent, ripe, tropical fruit and all the classic Sauvignon character one could wish for. This is from the Pask winery on the outskirts of Hastings

502 Sancerre, André Dezat et Fils 2019 £28.00

André Dezat and his sons produce one of the best Sancerres we have tasted; it is dry, fruity with a wonderfully delicate bouquet and great length. Their vineyards have three different types of soil which give added complexity.

Red

513 Beaujolais, Jacques Charlet, France, 2018 £19.00

White flower aromas are followed by raspberry flavours in the mouth.

512 Domaine de l'Amandine, Seguret, Cotes du Rhone- Villages 2018 ✓ £24.00

A perfumed nose of ripe black cherry, spicy cranberries and red currants

514 Château Montaguillon, Montagne Saint-Emilion, France, 2017 £29.00

Red fruit character of plums, blackcurrants and cherries backed up by good structure and ripe tannins

Rosé wine

France

301 Piquepoul, Les Vignobles Foncalieu, 2019 ✓ 175ml Glass £9.00 £36.00

A dry, elegant pale pink Rosé, made from the rarely used Piquepoul Noir grape, packed with refreshing red fruit flavours with a strong strawberry nose.

304 Sancerre Rosé, Domaine Semele, 2017 £45.00

The rosés of Sancerre are made from Pinot Noir, not so surprising as Sancerre is closer to Burgundy than to Muscadet. This dry rosé is deliciously light with strawberry fruit.

Italy

305 Pinot Grigio Mirabello, 2019 ✓ £29.00

This is an off-dry, fruity rosé, with plenty of strawberry flavours and lively, refreshing acidity.

Argentina

307 Los Haroldos Malbec Rosado, 2018 ✓ 175ml Glass £7.25 £29.00

A bright nose of strawberries and cherries. The palate is creamy but light and refreshing with plenty of red fruit and just a delicate hint of sweetness



White wine

France

219 Muscadet de Sèvre et Maine Sur Lie, Château du Cléray, 2018 175ml Glass £8.25 £34.00

Steely and focused, well defined citrus and stone fruit, flowing seamlessly into notes of wet stone. Dry and incisive on the palate, with great length and a hint of mint.

229 Pinot Gris, Turckheim Reserve, Alsace, 2018 **V** £34.00

Made with carefully selected grapes, this is a rich, ripe and rounded, although still dry, wine. Pale golden yellow with floral and spice aromas, very textural with a long, slightly smoky finish.

207 Picpoul de Pinet, Domaine des Lauriers 2019 £28.00

Floral and enticing on the nose, exuberantly fresh on the palate, a slightly salty edge and underlying minerality. This is an fruity Picpoul, fine and elegant, with a long finish.

210 Petit Chablis Domaine la Motte, 2018 £49.00

Ripe lemon on the nose. The palate is well balanced with fresh zesty fruit and a long citrusy finish, remarkable elegance and finesse. Far superior than the name 'Petit' might suggest.

245 Sancerre, Les Fondettes, Sauvion, 2019 175ml Glass £12.00 £49.00

Aromatic with white flowers and citrus fruits aromas and flinty notes. A lively wine with a good harmony combining richness, liveliness, and aromatic persistence.

255 Pouilly Fumé, Jean Pabiot, Domaine des Fines Caillottes, 2018 £54.00

Some of the best of modern vinification techniques with 5 generations of knowledge. This Estate gives a wine with excellent fruit and classic flintiness from some of the best vineyards in Pouilly.

208 Chablis Premier Cru, Domaine Daniel Séguinot Fourchaume 2016 £65.00

Just 4ha on south-west facing Kimmeridgian slopes, these grapes are brought to full ripeness despite the marginal climate. Fine fruit with an abundance of texture there is also finesse and a classic nervy edge to the finish. This vineyard is still run by Daniels daughters on fabulous old vines.

214 Meursault, Vieilles Vignes, Domaine Vincent Girardin 2017 £99.00

From the Côte d'Or this just exudes sunshine - the colour, the intense tropical fruit tempered by a lime stream with notes of parsley and fresh coriander leaves, just enough oak to add a crumb of biscuit and nothing in there that doesn't need to be - works impressively well!

Italy

249 Pinot Grigio Bottega Trentino 2018 **V** 175ml Glass £8.50 £34.00

Lightly honeyed spicy nose with distinct floral, apple and citrus notes. A touch of white spice, green olive and almond. It shows nutty flavours with crisp, lemon. A great finish.

223 Gavi Di Gavi, Nuovo Quadro, 2018 **V** £40.00

A nose of white peach, pear and acacia blossoms with hints of fresh lime and gooseberry.

259 Fina 'Vola Vola' Viognier, Sicilia IGP, 2019 £41.00

Straw coloured, a very, very silky texture with loads of weight, this is a great example of Viognier. Bruno Fina, grows grapes at 750m, ensuring that delicate orange and apricot aromas are kept intact



Spain

224 Albarino, La Val Orballo, Rias Baixas, 2018 £35.00
Very bright and pale lemon in colour. Fruity citrus aromas blend with fragrant mountain herbs on the nose.

Germany

254 Erdener Treppchen Riesling Kabinett, Meulenhof, Mosel 2018 £39.00
A racy, juicy style, with lots of fresh-cut apple and citrus flavors that feature interesting notes of fennel and minerals.

Austria

202 Grüner Veltliner, Müller-Grossmann, Satz Viertel, Kremstal 2018 £37.00
Grüner Veltliner, known locally to make the best wine rarely leaves Austria and Hungary and is possibly one of their best kept secrets. Bright and fresh with lively yellow fruit flavours and good tension with just a hint of pepperiness.

South Africa

251 Chenin Blanc, Boars Kloof, 2019 £29.00
Peppery and aromatic, with tropical fruit flavours of ripe fig and melon backed up with crisp, refreshing acidity.

237 Sauvignon Blanc, Steenbok, Swartland, 2019 £30.00
Full of intense gooseberry and passionfruit flavour, offset by subtle notes of ripe figs, lemongrass and capsicum.

Australia

260 Unoaked Chardonnay, Bushranger, 2018 ✓ 175ml Glass £8.00 £32.00
Rich and creamy mouth feel that leads to lovely soft tropical fruits and orange zest on the palate.

201 Barry and Sons Riesling, 2019 £42.00
The Barrys have amassed one of the largest family holdings in Australia's Clare Valley, which is particularly good Riesling country. Whiffs of lime and citrus and a zesty mineral palate to drink now or have patience.

New Zealand

236 Sauvignon Blanc, Fellowship Marlborough, 2019 175ml Glass £8.75 £35.00
Plenty of crisp fruit with hints of grapefruit and fresh-cut herbs in a clean, fresh-tasting package with lots of zip.

Argentina

239 Torrontes, Quara Estate, 2019 £35.00
Floral, green aromas and flavors of pressed roses, lychee, peach compote, and aloe.

USA

256 Chardonnay, Wente 'Morning Fog', 2018 ✓ £45.00
Bright and crisp flavours of pear, melon, citrus and green apple are balanced by subtle hints of toasty oak.



Red wine

France

417 Beaujolais-Villages, Rémi Benon 2018 V £32.00

Classically floral-tinged berry fruits, notes of redcurrant but also darker notes of plum. Lively, fresh and vital, with good purity; there is ample weight in the mouth and a soft round finish showing its generous nature.

456 Fleurie, Le Pigeonnier Du Chapitre, 2018 175ml Glass £10.50 £39.00

Elegant, fragrant with expressive red berry fruit. Historically linked to the monasteries, this Chateau's old vines give beautifully deep flavours, rich in raspberry and floral notes yet holding the typical structure of Fleurie.

459 Les Roches De Yon Figeac, Saint-Emilion Grand Cru, 2015 175ml Glass £14.00 £59.00

Lots of soft, sweet fruit and very subtle tannins make this a very fresh yet rich outstanding Bordeaux.

430 Domaine De La Cendrillon 'Inédite', Corbières 2015 £55.00

Complex and intense with plenty of herby fruit and great depth. Silky and long with just a touch of oak. From an estate looking to be the best in Corbières. This wine is a blend of 50% Syrah, 30% Grenache & 20% Mourvedre.

408 Château Cissac, Haut-Médoc, Bordeaux 2016 £61.00

Textbook Médoc with plenty of juicy, chunky blackcurrant fruit, firm tannins and fine length. Cissac's new style has good balance, and is no longer overwhelmed by the tannin levels of pre-2000 vintages.

413 Châteauneuf du Pape 'Tradition', Domaine Giraud, 2018 £79.00

Silky and seductive, with wonderful fruit, smooth and rich with good tannins and spice on the finish. There is good structure, but this is a superbly balanced wine that will age well. An incredibly pretty wine, considering its BIG, rich and impressive in scale. Lots of raspberry, but also liqueur-like kirsch and blackberry. Layered and silky. This is how you do elegant Grenache.

403 Gevrey Chambertin, En Champs, Louis Jadot, Burgundy, 2017 £85.00

Spicy, earthy, menthol, herbal, and strawberry aromas. A dry, tight, somewhat leaner palate with some chalky tannins and fresh acidity. Raspberry, carrot top, celery salt, spice, tobacco leaf, herbaceous and gamey flavours. This wine is ripe and ready to drink with perfect aging.

402 Chateau Gruaud-Larose, Cru Classe Cru Saint-Julien, 2004, Bordeaux £130.00

An impressive vintage from a very consistent property. The fruit is ripe and succulent and well-balanced, good intense finish. Served at the royal table, hence the famous inscription that still appears on the label, le roi des vins, le vin des rois ("the king of wines, the wine of kings). Gruaud-Larose being recognized for many years as Saint Julien's most massive wine.

414 Chapelle-Chambertin Grand Cru, Drouhin-Laroze, Burgundy 2014 £147.00

Peppery with savoury, intense black fruit flavours and well integrated tannins, this is one of the earliest drinking of Domaine Drouhin-Laroze's stunning grand cru wines. Chapelle-Chambertin is a small vineyard that lies

412 Volnay 1er Cru "Les Angles", Domaine Louis Boillot & Fils, Burgundy, 2016 £163.00

It has plenty of fruit on the nose: mint-tinged raspberry preserve and smudged strawberry. The palate has good substance with raspberry and blackberry notes, fine structure and what you might call a "solid" finish.

Italy

463 Montepulciano d'Abruzzo, Ancora, 2018 £31.00

Deep, ruby-red colour with violet highlights and a pleasant and fruity bouquet. Dry, and round on the palate with hints of red fruit.

432 Prunatelli, Chianti, 2018 £31.00

Rich, velvety, full-flavoured and warming with hints of vanilla and raspberries on the nose.

466 Rive, Barbera D'Asti, Italy, 2016 V £42.00

Deep garnet hue, vibrant aromas of black cherries, prunes, chocolate and toasty oak, hint dried fennel. Vibrant redcurrants, black cherries and a touch of spice show through on the palate, which has a rich, smooth taught acidity and fine oak texture

422 Capitel della Crosara, Amarone della Valpolicella Classico, 2015 £79.00

Intense deep ruby red in colour, with concentrated aromas of currants, blueberries and cherries.



Spain

424 Rioja Vega, Crianza, 2017 £38.00
Smooth, soft, richly-fruited red, has spice and vanilla from 12 months in American oak.

Australia

428 'House of Certain Views' Shiraz, 2016 £35.00
Blackberry fruits meets smoky bacon and wait for those soft silky tannins to kick in. Pure velvet!

427 Trentham Estate, Pinot Noir 2018 £41.00
The palate is full and structured with rich plummy fruit. Tannins are fine giving a smooth mouthfeel. palate with dark and summer fruit compote flavours, along with some savoury, smoky bacon and dried herb notes.

401 Barry and Son's Shiraz, 2016 £42.00
A smooth easy drinking Shiraz with rich dark fruit flavours, full body and velvety tannins. A perfect drink for red meat and casual enjoyment.

Argentina

442 Malbec, Caoba, 2019 175ml Glass £9.50 £38.00
Soft, elegant and persistent, with flavours of plums, cherries, currants and raspberries, a pinch of spice and cocoa.

Chile

436 Cabernet-Sauvignon, Ladera Verde, 2019 £27.00
Very juicy wine, well-balanced, easy to drink. Light, obvious fruity nose.

460 Merlot, San Perito, 2018 175ml Glass £7.25 £29.00
Deep and vibrant red in colour, this wine has a signature aroma of spices perfectly highlighted by coffee notes.

USA

452 Zinfandel, Burlesque Old Vine, 2018 175ml Glass £9.50 £38.00
This traditional Lodi Old Vine Zinfandel is fruit packed with dark damson fruit and a flash of black pepper.



Dessert Wines

France

607 Coteaux du Layon, St Aubin Domaine des Forges, 2018 **V**

50ml £3.75 750ml £41.00

The wine finishes with lovely pineapple fruit. Wine demonstrates the world class potential of this variety.

609 Monbazillac, Domaine de Grange Neuve, 2017

50ml £4.40 500ml £36.00

Deep gold in colour, pungent barley sugar and honey on the nose.

Spain

603 Chardonnay (Late Harvest), Príncipe de Vi Vendimia Tardia, Navarra, 2017

50ml £4.40 500ml £44.00

Deeply complex with notes of tinned pineapple, apricot, quince, orange peel and rosemary honey.

USA

608 Black Muscat, Quady Elysium, California, 2017

50ml £5.50 375ml £41.00

Virtually black in colour, with a rose-like aroma, very intense on the palate and full of fantastic rich velvety fruit.
